# ROAMING REQUIREMENTS

Thank you for your enquiry regarding our roaming puppets. Please see below the requirements for Roaming.

Confirmation of Engagement (Ideally 4 weeks prior) that clearly indicates the following:

- What roaming act you are booking
- Number of artists/puppets engaged
- Dates, Time and Location

## Roaming Schedule

Artists are engaged for an 8 hour period, door to door. This includes travel time, loading/unloading, set up, roaming rec and performance.

Our roaming performance duration is 30mins (20mins for Human Body Parts) with 45mins break in between. A maximum of x3 Roams can be performed in an 8 hour period, including travel time, loading and set up.

#### Backstage

We require a secure green room (with toilet facilities nearby) for performers to warm up in and puppet storage between roams. The area needs to be at least 6m x 6m, and not shared – a dedicated room with locking door is best.

- Access to water, and power (standard 10amp, 240v power outlet)
- Clothes rack and coathangers
- Table and chairs
- Site map specifying roam area(s)
- Air-conditioning / heating where required

## Weather

It is important to note that weather conditions [rain, heat and humidity] may affect the ability of the puppets to perform. Where the temperature or conditions are deemed unsafe, the tour manager must notify the site Event Manager. Where artists cannot perform due to weather, it is appreciated that all parties will endeavour to reschedule performances or revise performance style.

#### Marketing

Neither you nor Snuff Puppets will release programming or engagement announcements until both parties consider the agreement finalised. All print and online marketing materials will be approved by Snuff Puppets prior to release. Snuff Puppets will provide you with copy and high quality images for all marketing and publicity purposes.
